NOTICE FOR THE SELECTION OF PROPOSALS FOR MINICURES AND WORKSHOPS AT THE INTERNATIONAL CONGRESS AWAKENING VOCATIONS - COINTER PDV 2020

The INTITUTO INTERNACIONAL DESPERTANDO VOCAÇÕES - IIDV - makes public, for the knowledge of interested parties, that registration is open for the presentation of proposals for short courses and workshops in the areas of Bachelor's degrees, Agricultural Sciences, Management, Technology and Health Sciences of the International Congress Awakening Vocations - COINTER PDV 2020, which will take place from 02 to 05 December 2020, on the virtual platform PDV Learning

1. OBJECT AND PLACES

The purpose of this Regulation is to select proposals for short courses and workshops in the areas of Agrarian Sciences, Licenciatura, Management, Technology and Health Sciences that will be held between December 2, 2020 to December 5, 2020, including execution and evaluation.

1.1 MODALITIES:

Workshops and short courses: Hours varying from 4 am to 12 pm, distributed during the days of the event.

1.2 THEMATIC AXES OF THE CONTEMPLATED AREAS:

Bachelor's Degrees: Teacher Training, Concepts Learning, Curriculum and Educational Policies, Learning Assessment, Science Didactics, Didactic Games in Education, CTSA Movement, Planning and Management, Technology in Education, Teaching and Learning Processes.

Agrarian Sciences: Agrarian Sciences, Agroecology, Rural Sociology, Agricultural Training, Rural Education, Health and Environment, Agriculture, Rural Administration and Economy, Food Science and Technology, Technology and Innovation, Fisheries Engineering and its Technologies, Agriculture and Technologies.



Management and Technology: Sustainability, Innovation, Strategy, Automation, Mechatronics, Civil Construction, Entrepreneurship, Economic Approaches, Public Policies, Creative Economy, Social Projects, Information and Communication Technologies, Smart Cities, People Management. Architecture and Urbanism, Engineering I, II, III, IV

Health Sciences: Clinical applications, Biomaterials, Educational Health Practices, Basic Sciences, Health Education, Community Education, Health Promotion, Popular Education, Educational Technologies, Epidemiology, Management, Public Health, Patient Safety and Bioethics.

1.1 PLACES WHERE MINICURES AND WORKSHOPS WILL BE HELD:

The event will be online, so the offer of mini courses and workshops will also be virtual, through the PDV Learning platform.

2. OF THE BIDDERS:

2.1. Only people registered at the event, directly responsible for planning and executing their proposals, may submit proposals.

2.2. The same proponent may present mini-course projects and / or workshops that will be given during COINTER PDV - 2020 for the areas of Bachelor's degrees (PDVL), Agrarian Sciences (PDVAgro), Management and Technology (PDVGT) and Health Sciences (PDVS).

2.3. The proponent's proposals need to be aligned with the event's theme and must contain a menu that supports the development of activities, as well as, it must contain theoretical support in the proposal for a mini-course and workshop.

2.4. The proponent must present a curriculum and respective supporting documents, with emphasis on didactic and pedagogical experiences consistent with his proposal.



2.5. In case of approval of the proposal, the proposer agrees, if the Organizing Committee deems it appropriate, to adjust and adapt its proposal to be implemented in another modality.

3. REGISTRATION:

- **3.1**. Registration will be through ONLINE FORM through the link: https://bit.ly/minicursoseoficinas2020
- **3.2**. The workshop and / or short course must be submitted at the time of registration until the date indicated in the schedule;
- **3.3**. Those interested in participating in the selection process must file their proposals from July 4th to July 31st, 2020;
- **3.4**. The act of registering the proposal in the selection process implies acceptance of all the conditions stipulated in the present regulation;

4. REQUIREMENTS:

- **4.1.** The tenderer must present the minimum degree of specialist, duly proven;
- **4.2.** The workshop and / or short course proposal must be in accordance with your area of training and / or professional experience;

5. THE RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE SELECTED BIDDER:

- **5.1.** Define precisely all the elements contained in the registration form in Annex I:
- **5.2.** Be available on the pre-established date and time, in a virtual way, to answer any questions from congressmen about the short course or workshop given.
- **5.3.** It is the responsibility of the lecturer to have any of the following devices, computer (desktop) or notebook, with internet access and with audio and video features, for online teaching of the workshop / mini-course.



5.4. Be available for possible guidance on the use of the platform that will be used to teach the mini-course.

6. DOCUMENTS FOR SELECTION:

- **6.1.** Fill and send the registration form; (form described in item 3.1)
- **6.2.** Complete and attach to the registration form in the Workshop / Short Course Plan (Annex 1).
- **6.3.** Lattes Curriculum link proving your training and study area, with emphasis on didactic experiences.

7. CANCELLATION OF THE PROPOSAL

- **7.1** Entries with incomplete completion of the "Registration Form" or that are not in accordance with the rules of this notice will be denied;
- **7.2** If the Selection Committee examines and proves that the proposal is not consistent with any area (s) indicated, the proposal will be immediately excluded from the process.

8. SELECTION CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING PROPOSALS

The selection of proposals will be carried out in two stages, namely:

- **8.1 First stage ELIMINATORY**: analysis of proposals and curriculum 10 (ten) points;
- **8.1.1** In the first stage, the Selection Committee will analyze the proposals and curriculum, assigning up to 10 (ten) points, taking into account the following elements:
- a) Proof of academic background and teaching experience of the applicant 03 (three) points;



- **b)** Coherence of the proposal considering the guidelines of the areas contemplated in the event 04 (four) points;
- c) Link between the candidate's training and practice with the submitted proposal 03 (three) points.
- **8.1.2** The score for the first stage consists of the sum of the previous scores. The maximum score will be 10 (ten) points;
- **8.1.3** Proposals that obtain a score equal to or greater than 7 (seven) points will be classified for the second stage.

8.2 Second stage - 10 (ten) points.

- a) Being a member of IIDV 03 (three) additional points;
- **b)** Have proof that you have given workshops and / or mini courses at previous events 01 (one) additional point for certification. Maximum score of 07 (seven) points.
- **8.2.2** The score for the second stage consists of the sum of the previous scores. The maximum score will be 10 (ten) points;
- **8.2.3** The final grade is made up of the sum of the scores from the first and second stages. The maximum score will be 20 (twenty) points.
- 9. Tiebreaker criteria:
- 9.1. Being a member of the IIDV;
- 9.2. Registration order;
- 10. Dissemination of results:



10.1. The final result will be announced on August 15, 2020 on the event website.
